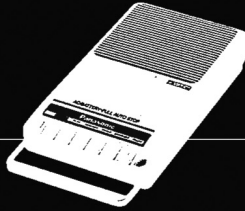

The Blank Tape Spillage Fete is the result of a year-long project co-ordinated by two friends who still record music onto tapes.

In 2005, 21 musicians and artists making music were sent a blank cassette tape, along with a request to fill it up with their own sounds and music. They were all asked also to produce the accompanying artwork or packaging.

The exhibition consists of prints, paintings, drawings, graphics and sculpture produced by the contributors overleaf.

Their music ranges from folk rock, electronica, lo-fi punk pop to noise and spoken word, and can be heard on individual listening posts.

There is a launch gig for the Fete on Sunday 27 August, 4-11pm, featuring many of the Spillagers playing their contributions live. Admission is £3.
